	Science = Everyday Materials - How Have Humans Changed Our Planet?
Year 3	DT = How can you make parts of a picture move? - Linkages and Levers
	Science = Forces & Magnets - How can I move objects without touching them?
Year 4	DT = Function or appearance – what is more important? – Simple circuits and switches
	Science = Electricity - What is the best way to build a circuit?
Year 5	DT = How can a mechanism solve a problem? - Pulleys & Gears
	Science = Forces - What would life be like without forces?
Year 6	DT = What makes an effective shelter? Frame Structures
	Science = Light - Why can't we see in the dark?


