Dear Parents / Carers.

Our 'Word of the Week' and 'Golden Expectation of the Week' were 'Understanding' & 'Listen respectfully and follow instructions'. Please ask your child(ren) what this word and phrase means to them and why they are important.

Now that our Y6's have sat all of their **KS2 SATs** they are enjoying a trip to the cinema today to watch Encanto. Many of the year group are also looking forward to enjoying a residential trip to Danbury in the final week of the half-term. I personally would like to say a massive well done to all of our Y6 pupils, and their teachers(!) as well as yourselves as parents for your on-going support and understanding over the last three academic years. 


