Reception had the opportunity to meet the Metropolitan Police.



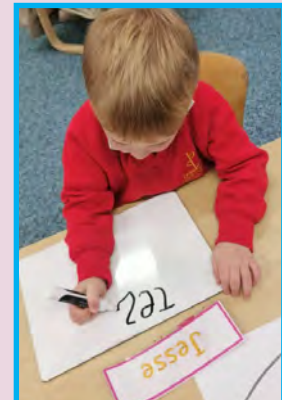
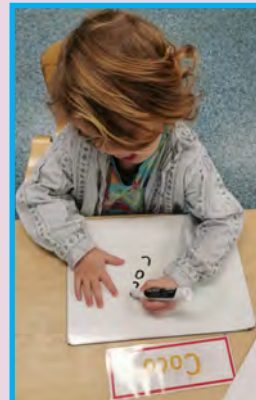
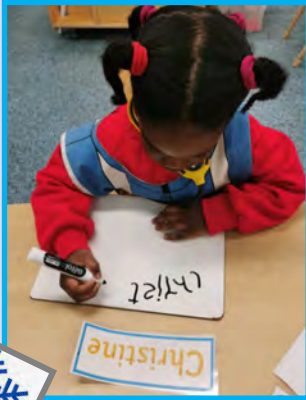
The Police officers shared what they do and how they help us. We enjoyed looking at their uniforms and exploring their equipment.

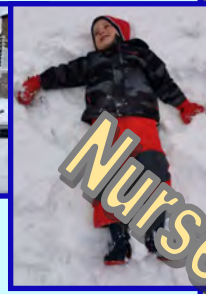
On Friday 9th December Daubeney Primary school were all served a delicious Christmas dinner. All the children and staff wore their beautiful winter or Christmas themed jumpers.

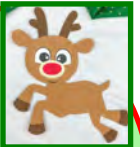

Nursery have been rehearsing and practising actions for their Christmas performance. They sang all these wonderful songs.

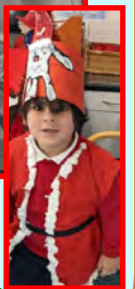
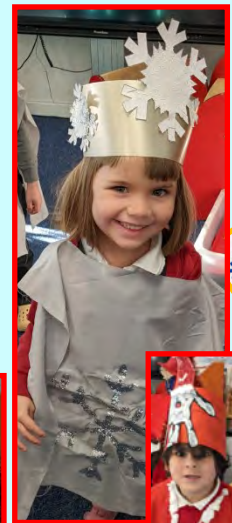
