It feels strange to say, but our year 6 children are entering their final 5 weeks of primary school. There is a lot happening in the next 5 weeks, so we wanted to let you know about some key dates, whilst also giving you a bit more information about the Year 6 Graduation Ceremony.

The Graduation Ceremony will take place on **Thursday 20th July at 09.30am** in the Main School Playground and will conclude at approximately 10:30am. Year 6 students attending the graduation ceremony will be expected to wear full school uniform. **This year each child will be able to invite up to 2 adults**. Children will begin school at the normal time of 8:45am and the accompanying adult/s should aim to arrive at 9:00am (and be seated by 9.25am in the playground).

The Leavers' Party will take place on **Thursday 20th July in The Hop Garden** and it will begin at **4pm** and will conclude at **6pm**, at which point your child will either make their own way home or be collected by a family member from the school. All children will receive a celebration meal at the disco consisting of a burger, juice and ice-cream (all dietary requirements will be catered for). As this is a celebration, and an event the children will want to remember and cherish, we are allowing them to bring cameras so they can take pictures. If they don't have a camera, they can bring a mobile phone, but these are only to be used to take photos.
