Re: Year 4 Multiplication Timetables Check

Dear Parents and Carers,

Your child will be participating in the statutory multiplication timetables check (MTC) which is part of the national curriculum assessments in June 2024. It is an on-screen check consisting of 25 times table questions. Your child will then have 6 seconds to answer each question. On average, the check should take no longer than 5 minutes to complete.

The purpose of the check is to determine whether your child can fluently recall their times tables up to 12, which is essential for future success in mathematics. It will also help the school identify if your child may need additional support.

At the beginning of this spring term your child scored out of 25 on a similar test. While every effort is being made at school to ensure your child's success at this check, you can further support your child by allowing regular access to the following websites which provide free, interactive and fun activities to help:
