- Please check your child's book bag everyday as there may be letters and other important information.






- PE and Music will take place Monday morning.

DAILY PHONICS

- Daily Phonics will start with Phase 1.
- We use a Blossom Federation Phonics programme
- Phonics sessions will be within class until children are assessed and placed into smaller working groups.

OUTDOOR PLAY

- Children will have the opportunity to free flow outside every day.
- There will be a mix of different activities outside including gross motor toys, creative, maths and literacy resources, construction area, sand pit and a reading area.

BASELINE

- We will be completing the statutory baseline over the next few weeks.
- Your child will work with a class teacher to complete the assessment.
- The assessment is made up of different activities including games, counting and answering word based questions.
- Data from this assessment will go to the DfE and act as an On-Entry Data for when children start school.

TRIPS

- Children will be offered opportunities for trips throughout the year.
- Trips will start locally starting with Daubeney Fields, Local Church and the library.
- We have a trip booked in for Autumn 2 for a story telling exhibition.
