### **Supporting your child - Maths**

- Timestable Rockstars
- Times table challenges
- Ask your children to help you cook, shop or help around the house (maths is everywhere)
- Ask teacher for resources to support with bridging gaps
- BBC Bitesize/youtube maths

### **Supporting your child - Reading**

- Bring reading records and reading books in **everyday**
- Complete reading records (reading skills)
- Book bands
- Reading for pleasure
- Read to your children/have your children read to you (this can be done anywhere, anytime)
- Encourage independent reading
- Every day for 30 mins
- Ask them what they are reading/what is it about


